



No parking at Museum; public lots are located nearby.


Security Screening



Frequently Asked Questions

Where is the nearest Metrorail (subway) stop?

Exit out the Independence Avenue doors, go one block straight ahead on 6th Street, cross Maryland Avenue at the stoplight, and turn right. The L'Enfant Plaza station is just down the street.

How do I get to the Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center?

The Udvar-Hazy Center is about 28 miles (a 40-minute drive) from downtown Washington. Public transportation is available via regional bus service or taxi; visit the Welcome Center for information.

What else should I know?

Welcome Center

Visitor Services volunteers can tell you about what to see and do and answer any questions you may have. Located at the center of the Museum.

Guided Tours

Free 90-minute highlights tours daily at 10:30 and 1:00. No tickets or reservations required. Tours begin in front of the Welcome Center.

IMAX® Films and Planetarium Shows

Large-format IMAX® films and planetarium shows are shown daily. Visit the Theater box office (first floor) or Planetarium box office (second floor) for schedules and tickets.

Demonstrations

Daily demonstrations are held in the How Things Fly gallery. Also look for Discovery Cart demonstrations and other unscheduled activities.

Flight Simulator Rides

Located on the first floor, west end in Gallery 103. Tickets are required.

Food

The Wright Place Food Court is at the far east end, behind the Apollo lunar module.

Shopping

The Museum Store is near the center of the Museum, next to the Boeing Milestones of Flight Hall.
