

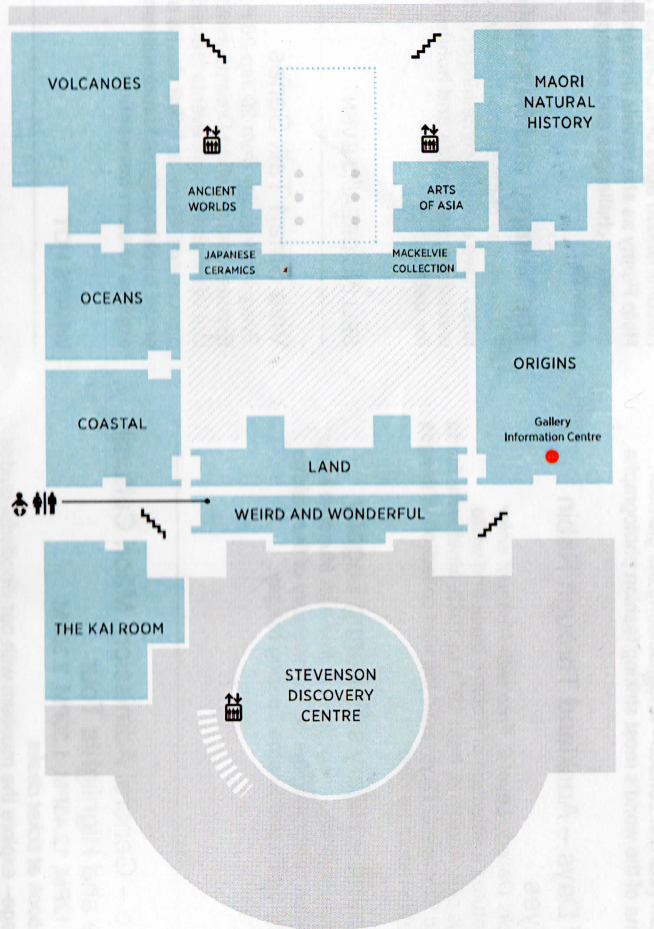
Ground level – People of the Pacific

From the great Pacific navigators - the Polynesians and New Zealand's indigenous people, the Maori - through to the pioneers who settled New Zealand in the 19th century.



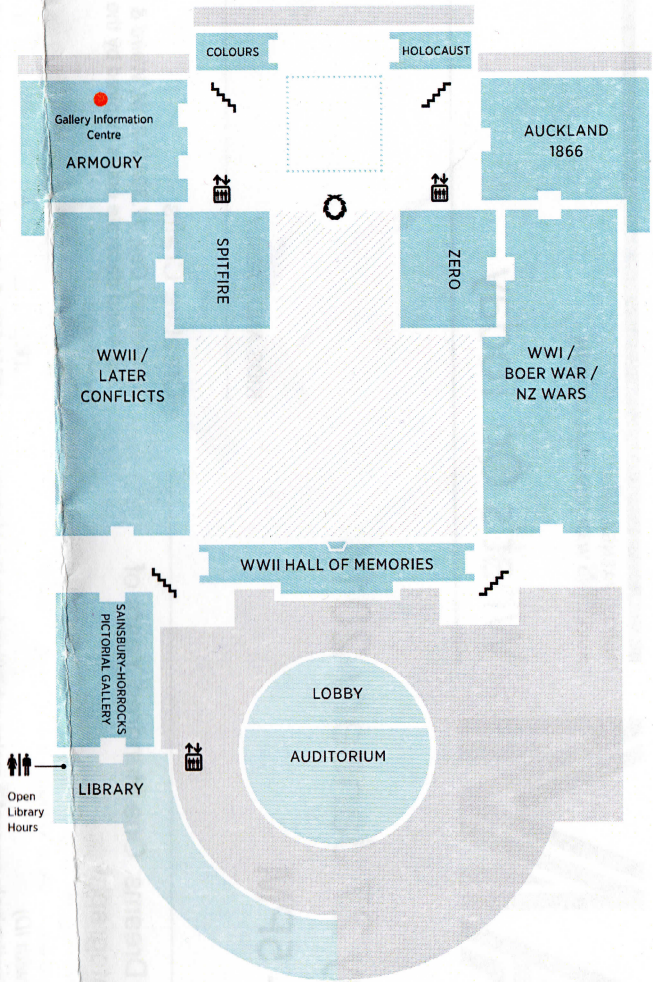
Level 1 – Stories of our Land and Sea
